



# Burrsville Infants Newsletter

As we speed towards Christmas, I would like to update you of the most recent news and updates from Burrsville Infant Academy.

## **Celebration Assemblies**

I am aware that last year parents were invited to attend Celebration Assemblies. I have decided to adapt how this will look going forward. We still have a Celebration Assembly every week but they are considerably shorter – lasting only 10 minutes so parents will no longer be invited to attend. This is due to us prioritising the curriculum and outcomes. We also find that if parents are unable to attend then this can cause dysregulation and upset for some pupils. It is also about protecting the well-being of staff – when parents are invited to Celebration Assemblies this means teachers have to plan in advance which pupil will receive a certificate in Assembly. I would like this not to have to be so planned, allowing pupils to be chosen right up until the Assembly.

I appreciate that you may be disappointed by this decision which is why I am going to introduce Celebration Events at the end of every half term – all pupils that have received a certificate will be invited to attend with their parents where hot chocolate and cake will be served, and you will get to spend time with your child celebrating their success. The dates will be set at the beginning of the year so that you can plan accordingly. The event will be held at 2.30pm so that you can then take your child home.

Dates will also be published in this Newsletter where Open Mornings for different classes will be held so that parents are able to see what lessons look like and play a part in their child's education.

## **WOW Wall**

We have recently created a WOW wall in our entrance hall. Pupils' work will be added to the display each week. This is an opportunity to celebrate pupils who have worked really hard and produced an incredible piece of work. These pupils will also be invited to attend our celebration events. Make sure to pop in to see the work - it changes each week on a Friday.

## **Parent Survey**

Thank you to those of you who attended Parents Evening and filled in a Parent Survey. It was overwhelmingly positive with 99% of parents agreeing that they would recommend Burrsville to other parents. 95% of parents said their child was happy at school and 97% of parents said their child felt safe at school.

Most responses were positive but there were some aspects that scored slightly lower – these were linked to knowing what your child is learning and how well they are doing. From Spring Term each Year Group will be sending a Half Termly Overview to parents informing you of what your child will be learning. With reference to how well-informed parents feel about how their child is doing, we hold Parent Evenings three times a year, we send an interim report twice a year and an annual report once a year. You are welcome to meet with your child's class teacher at any point to discuss their academic progress.
