The children have had a brilliant week and are full of enthusiasm for science. We were even joined by Mr Caffull and children from the juniors who came to support our children with their learning. Thank you to everyone for your support and positivity regarding our new 3PR parking initiative. I have never seen the area outside of school so clear! Just a reminder, tokens will only be given to children who walk, cycle or scoot through the 3PR zone. Children using the back and side gates or attending breakfast club will also receive a token. Every Friday, the tokens are counted and the winning class receive the 3PR trophy at the end of each half term. Tokens will not be given to children whose parents block local residents' driveways; park in the cul-de-sac opposite the school; park on the bends of the cul-de-sac. Thank you so much for your on-going support with this matter. It has also been great to see many of you following the one-way system we have suggested. If you or your child are able to lend a hand and join us with our 3PR patrols and giving out tokens in the mornings, please let me know.

You may have seen our update regarding the COVID-19 pandemic on our school website. I will, of course, inform you as soon as I can if anything changes. In the meantime, I am following the advice I am receiving on a daily basis and continuing to promote regular handwashing and the 'catch it, kill it, bin it' strategy. Mr Baker and his cleaning team are working hard to ensure the school is cleaned to a high standard, which includes cleaning door handles and light switches. I know many of you are feeling quite anxious about the situation but rest assured, we are following the advice we have been given. Have a great weekend.
