Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another exciting week in school and I have enjoyed being able to spend some time in each classroom, observing teaching and looking at the children's books. The staff are all working so hard under very different circumstances. It has been lovely talking to the children about their learning this week and seeing how excited they are.

You should have received a letter I sent yesterday about the new start and finish times we are trialling from next week. I hope these changes will mean you are waiting around less in the cold and there will be less gathering. Thank you once again to everyone who is following our social distancing guidelines and wearing a mask when on the school site. Yes, they are uncomfortable, hot and nobody likes wearing them, but we are wearing them to protect each other and prevent the spread of Covid-19.

There has also been a lot of information around our Christmas plans shared this week. If you haven't received any emails, please check your junk and clutter boxes and contact the school office if you still can't find them.

Following a further three parking incidents this week, where distressed parents have shared they have had to pull their children out of the way from cars recklessly mounting the kerb to park, Mrs Wright and I have been making further enquiries to local councillors, Essex County Council and the North Essex Parking Partnership to seek advice on our next steps. My advice to you all is to please report any issues directly to Essex County Council. We will continue to follow any advice we get from other agencies.

Now the weather is getting colder, please ensure your child brings a warm coat to school and any scarves and gloves are named. This makes reuniting lost items with their owners much easier. Thank you.

You may have seen on the last day of term we will be finishing at 1.30pm. We do this three times a year (at the end of the autumn, spring and summer terms) to allow staff to prepare their classroom environments for their new topics. As we will still be operating a staggered end to the school day, 1.30-1.40pm will be for children with siblings at Burrsville or Great Clacton, and 1.40-1.50pm will be for all other children.
