Dear Parents and Carers,

We've had a fantastic week in school with lots of learning taking place. It is great to see the children so excited and enthusiastic about their learning.

Next week you will be receiving a letter from Miss Jacobs about an exciting Royal Mail national competition we will be taking part in. The children will all be designing a stamp in school to commemorate the work of key workers across the country during the pandemic. Eight designs will be chosen by a special panel of judges and will be sent to Her Majesty The Queen before they can be printed and issued. I can't wait to see our children's designs.

Miss Jacobs has also been busy organising our participation in an Essex wide event - decorating an octopus sculpture. It is part of a large-scale public art and charity event to celebrate the 400 years since the birth of the Mayflower in Harwich and 150 Years of Clacton. All local schools have been invited to take part in this celebration of arts, culture and history. This summer, an array of large and small octopus sculptures will be on display across the county, forming a summer trail for you to follow. If you had a child at Burrsville a few years ago, you may remember a similar event with a giraffe sculpture which the children decorated and was then on display in town. I can't wait to see how our octopus will look!

Another exciting event we have coming up is the NSPCC Number Day on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> May. We are asking children to dress up in something number related (for example, a football shirt with a number on or a onesie), for a donation of £1 per family. Mrs Tomaselli will also be organising number themed activities for throughout the day as well as holding a special assembly. All money raised will go to the NSPCC. Thank you in advance.

I hope you have all received your parents' evening appointment for next week. Mrs Green will be sending out a reminder of how you can access your appointment using Microsoft Teams. Prior to your appointment, your child's class teacher will also be posting a photograph of your child's English and maths work to Tapestry (EYFS) or Class Dojo (years 1 and 2).
