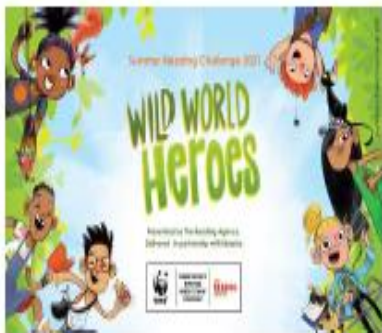

Thank you to all of you who offered support on Tuesday morning when there was a car accident in Craigfield Avenue. Thankfully, no one was hurt, but those involved were understandably left very shaken. The incident has acted as a reminder to us all of the importance of road safety around the school, especially at the beginning and end of the school day. On Wednesday the children were able to spend time in their new classrooms meeting their new teacher. The children had a great morning and there were lots of excited faces on Wednesday afternoon!

As I am sure you have heard, Covid restrictions are easing again on Monday. However, the DfE guidance states school who are still open next week can continue with their current procedures. With this in mind, as per our risk assessment please continue to wear a mask when on the school site (unless exempt) and we will continue with the rolling starts and collections. Unless the guidance changes over the summer, we will revert back to our usual times of the school day from September. This means the gates will open at 8.40am and all children must be in school for registration at 8.50am. The gate will open again at 2.50pm for parents to come onto the school site, and the children will be released when the school bell rings at 2.55pm. 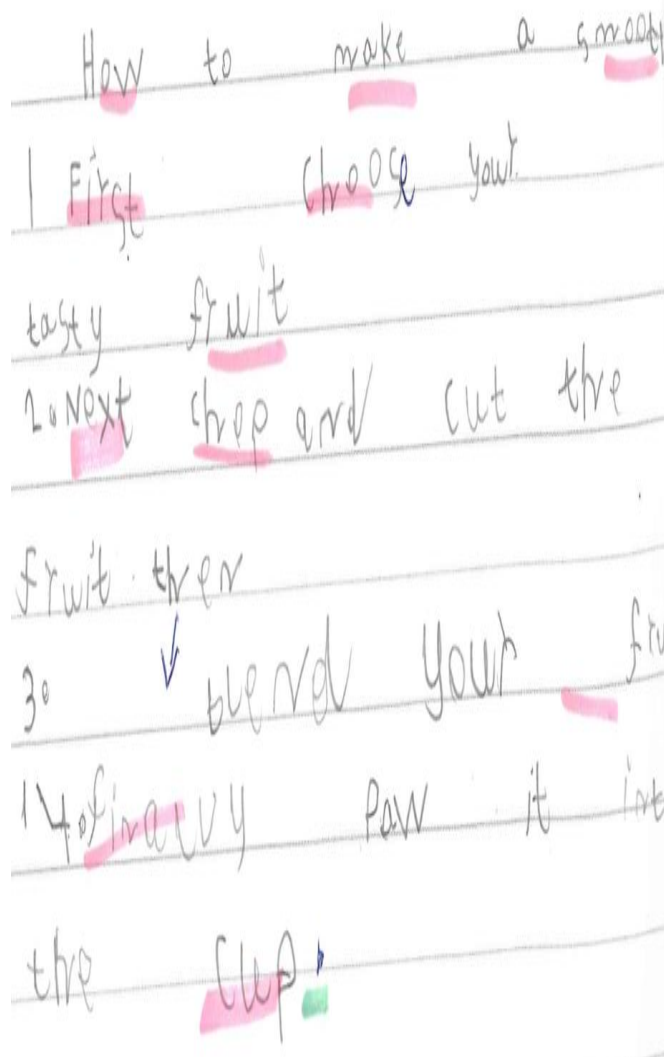
